**REGULATIONS REGARDING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE CARE AND SUPERVISION OF PARTICIPANTS' CHILDREN**

- ✦ Parents are responsible at all times for their children at Zhailau. The Kazakh Aul of the US cannot and will not assume responsibility for the care or supervision of people's children.
- ✦ The Geneva Point Center and Kazakh Aul of the US policy is that ALL children, regardless of age, must be supervised by an adult at all times. This includes anyone under the age of 16.
- ✦ It is the responsibility of each parent or guardian to ensure that his/her child(ren) are respectful of Geneva Point Center and Kazakh Aul of the US property (e.g., equipment, games, books, facilities, instruments, etc.). Parents will compensate the Geneva Point Center and/or the Kazakh Aul of the US for any damages incurred by themselves or their children.
- ✦ Due to safety concerns, NO children under the age of 18 will be allowed into the cooking area during Kazakh Cooking.
- ✦ Bike riders are required to wear helmets at all times, must yield to pedestrians in walkways, observe reasonable speeds, and must respond immediately to any adult request to stop or reduce speed. A formal written bicycle riding permission policy will be sent to all families. Bicycle riding at Zhailau is a privilege which can be revoked by the Kazakh Aul of the US or the Geneva Point Center.

### IMPORTANT PAYMENT DETAILS FOR DAY CAMPERS

- ✦ You may pay in full at registration, or you may opt to make two payments according to the following schedule:
  1. Due with registration: A *nonrefundable* deposit of 50% of your total Zhailau day fees/donations. This deposit will be a nonrefundable first payment for Zhailau participation.
  2. By June 11, 2010: All balances are due in full
- ✦ *All payments must be paid on time and it is the registrant's responsibility to submit all payments by the above noted dates. Failure to make any of the scheduled payments by their due dates may result in revocation of your Zhailau summer camp reservation and forfeiting of deposit paid.*
- ✦ Payment. Checks or money orders only, made payable to the Kazakh Aul of the U.S.

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### CONDITIONS FOR ENROLLMENT

1. The undersigned requests the Kazakh Aul of the U.S., Association for American & Kazakh Families, to reserve day participation for her/his family and guests listed above during the Zhailau Heritage Camp to be held July 26-31, 2010 at the Geneva Point Center in Moultonborough, NH. By signing below, the undersigned understands deposits are *nonrefundable*, and the undersigned agrees to comply with the payment schedule.
2. The undersigned, her/his family and guests agree to abide by the rules and regulations set by the Kazakh Aul of the U.S. and the Geneva Point Center for the health, safety and welfare of all campers.
3. Due to the fact that all camping programs are planned in advance to the opening of Camp including purchasing of campers' supplies, equipment and hiring of personnel, and are based on confirmed Camper reservations, no allowances, refunds or rebates can or will be made if cancellation occurs after June 11, 2010.
4. The Kazakh Aul of the U.S. and the Geneva Point Center are not responsible for articles of clothing or personal belongings lost or damaged by fire, theft, or laundering.
5. The undersigned consent to the use of any pictures and/or video of family members for the purpose of marketing or promotion.
6. I/We understand and acknowledge that certain activities provided by the Camp (including but not limited to swimming, canoeing, kayaking, sports, etc.) have an increased risk of injury. I/We further acknowledge and state that I/We will assume full responsibility for my/our family's safety and hereby agree to release and indemnify the Kazakh Aul of the U.S., Association for American & Kazakh Families, and the Geneva Point Center and all of their officers, employees, agents and representatives whatsoever, from any claims, cost, expense, including attorney fees and or damages which any of them may incur arising from my/our Family's participation in such activities.
